

AAUW ANNUAL REPORT, 2018-2019 – MEMBERSHIP TREASURER

For 2018-2019, the Poughkeepsie Branch paid National membership dues of \$16,925.31 and State dues of \$4,199.

I submitted the Branch Dues Report (BDR) on June 18, 2018, which included 268 renewing members, including five free memberships (allotted through the previous year's Shape the Future campaign), and one new member.

From August, 2018 through February, 2019, I submitted six Additional Dues Reports (ADRs). These reports listed 67 renewing members and 26 new members. For eligibility in the Shape the Future campaign, I submitted Guest Referral Reports following the September 6 Open House. We received three free memberships (the maximum allowed for 2018-2019), which must be redeemed by June 30, 2019. These will be drawn at the Annual Dinner on June 13.

Additionally, I submitted two more ADRs after March, 2019, allowing those new members to extend membership through June, 2020.

I provided a list of members who made additional donations with their renewal payments to the Board Secretary, who is responsible for sending thank you notes.

Other responsibilities included updating Quick Books with deposits made for membership renewals and recording contact changes noted on the renewal notices both on the National data base and as input to Claudette Hennessey for input to the Branch data base. As changes to members' contact information were noted throughout the year, I updated the National data base with those changes.

For FY 2019-2020, we are enrolled in National's MPP program, allowing us to submit renewals through National's online system with payments, both National and State, submitted with the Branch's credit card. As of the date of this report, I have received 177 renewals, which I will submit to National, along with any others I receive, after the June 13 Dinner.
